FRP : Free & Reduced Price

SBP : School Breakfast Program

NSLP : National School Lunch Program

Total Number of Students: the total number of students in the school district

FRP Rate: the percentage of enrolled students who are eligible for FRP meals

% FRP Students Participating in SBP: the percentage of students eligible for FRP meals who ate a school breakfast

SBP to NSLP Ratio: the number of all (regardless of income eligibility) students eating breakfast out of every 100 students eating lunch

FRP SBP to NSLP Ratio: the number of FRP eligible students eating a breakfast out of every 100 FRP eligible students eating lunch

Rank: Districts are ranked according to the number of FRP students participating in breakfast per every 100 participating in lunch.

**Districts with 35 or fewer FRP students were excluded for confidentiality reasons.
